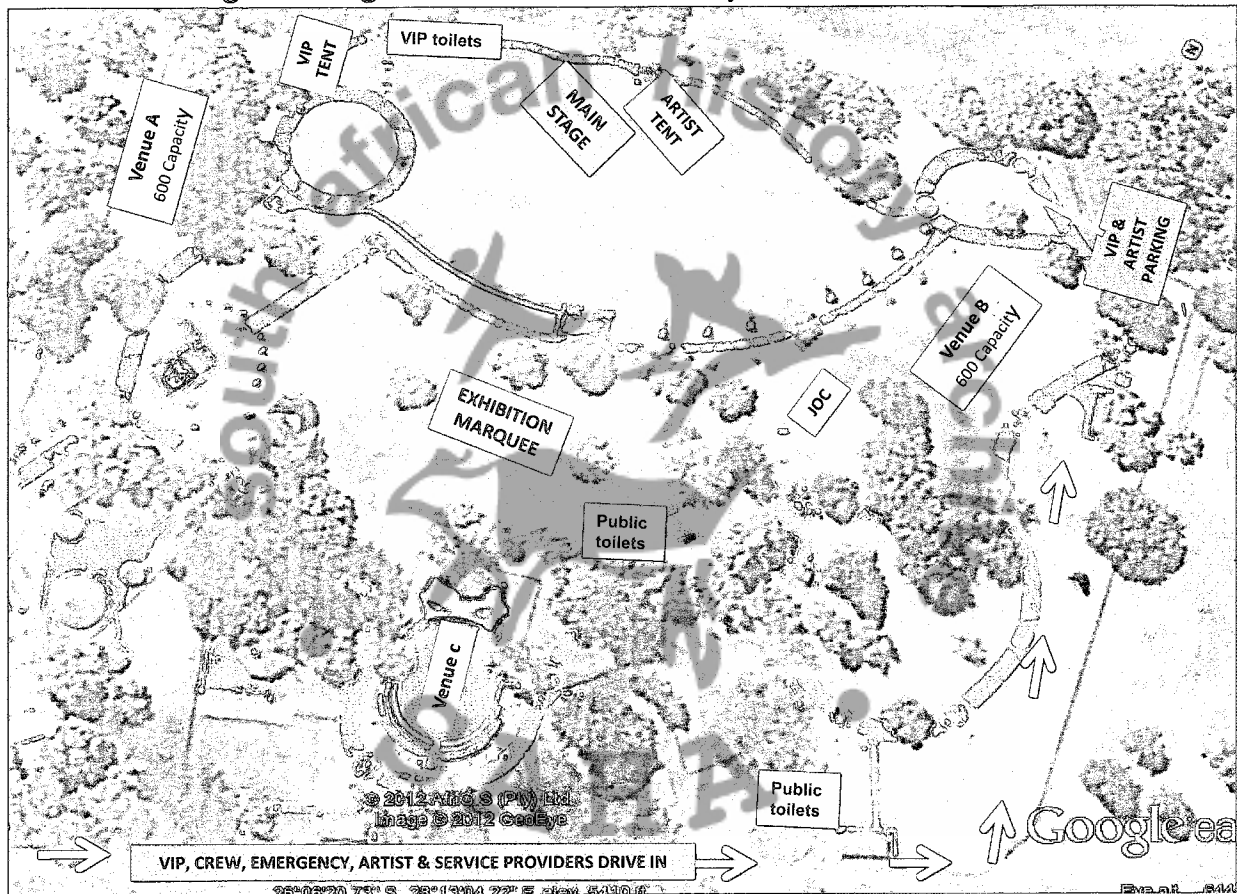

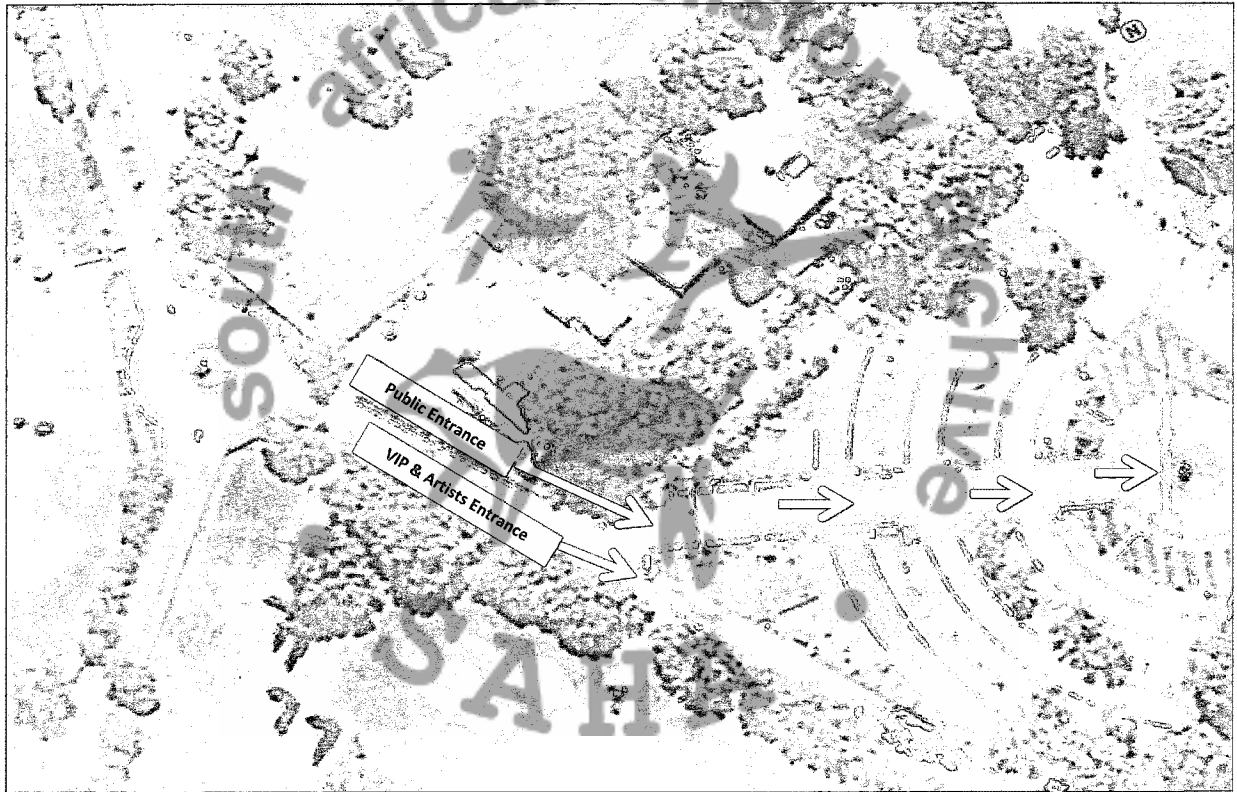

Welcome Village: Heritage Cultural Celebration Layout Plan



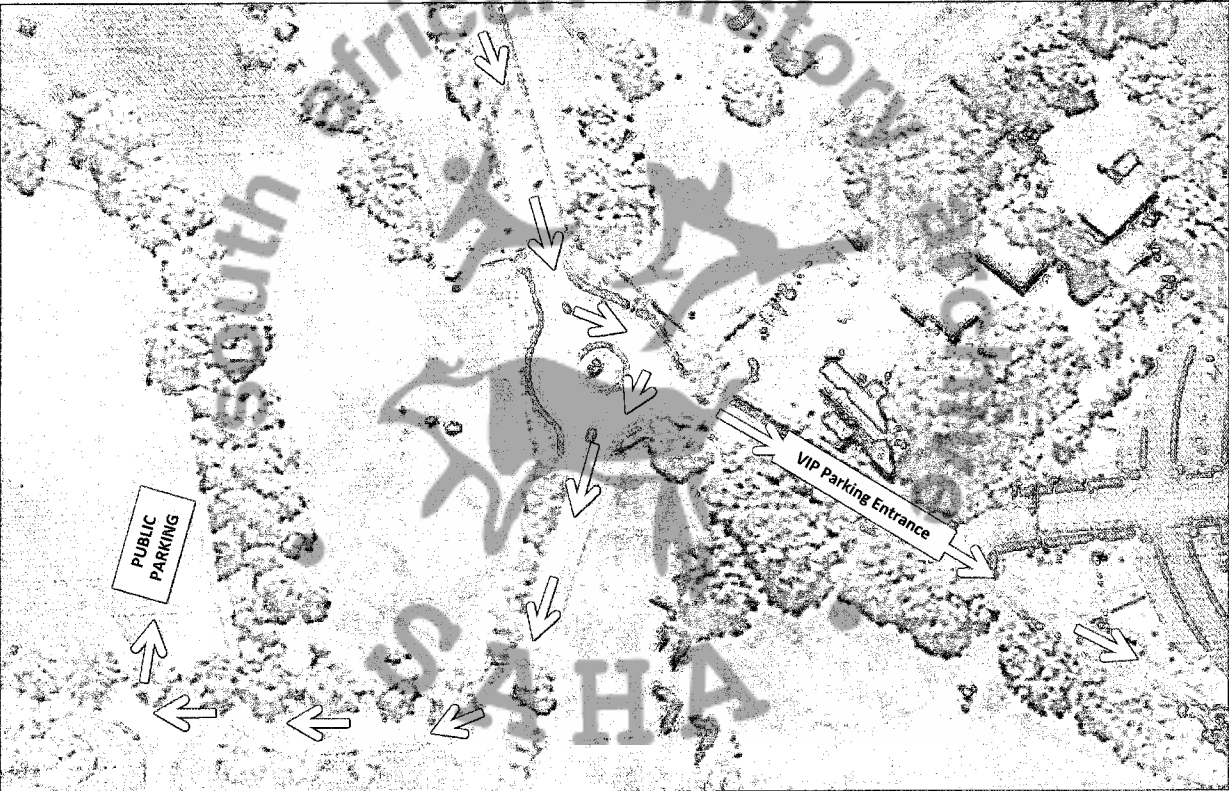
Main Entrance to the Village: Directive
