- (b) *held to form pressure groups, to hand over petitions to any person, or to mobilise or demonstrate support for or opposition to the views, principles, policy, actions or omissions of any person or body of persons or institutions, including any government, administration or governmental institutions."*



- (e) Phomolong/ Birch Acres Mall

From the gathering venues, they will move to the gathering point at Multi Purpose Hall, Emkhathini Section Tembisa.

At 10:00, they will then walk +/- 1 km to Tembisa Civic offices and hand over the memorandum.

It is expected that they will be finished by 13:00.

Threats (Before and during)

- Counsellors houses can be burned during the night on 2014-09-09 to 2014-09-10 between 18:00 to 06:00.
- Blockages to routes in the early hours of the morning.
- Damages to state vehicles/ community.
- Forcing other community members to join the strike.
