Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

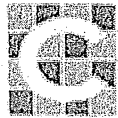

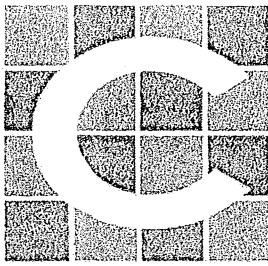
Hi Carina

DA unites with Alberton against crime

As residents of Alberton begin to join Alberton Day celebrations, the Democratic Alliance (DA) in Alberton will unite with other stakeholders and residents for a 5km walk against crime on Saturday December 6.
