Public Open Space

The layout plan makes provision for a number of Public Open Spaces, which are mainly positioned on environmental sensitive areas (i.e. the ridge in the south-eastern corner of the layout) or on areas that are not suitable for development. The Public Open Space takes up a total of 15.07 hectares of the total area of the site.

Agriculture

The northern part of the land development area can not be developed due to the existence of several physical restrictions including sinkholes, an old maturation pond and wetland area. It is proposed that this land be used for urban agricultural purposes. This area takes up almost 25% of the entire area of the site and measures 71.24 ha in extent.
