REQUEST FOR INFORMATION IN TERMS OF THE PROMOTION OF ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT, 2000 (ACT NO.2 OF 2000): SOUTH AFRICAN HISTORY ARCHIVE, SCHOOL FEEDING SCHEME 2014 TO THE PRESENT

The request for information has been received and response is provided as follows:

1) A list of authorised vendors contracted to supply the food

Response: The Free State Department of Education transfers funds to schools for the implementation of NSNP and as such the province does not have a list of authorised vendors to supply food for NSNP. Districts procure on behalf of Farm Schools and are using the centralised database system of suppliers.

2) The agreement between the school and suppliers to see whether it is in line with the guidelines of the NSNP (National School Nutrition Programme) with respect to amount, menu items, etc.

Response: These agreements are school specific between the SGB and the supplier.

3) The selection process of individuals who will cook/and or serve on a daily basis and whether their appointment is in line with the guidelines of the NSNP

Response: Volunteer Food Handlers are appointed according to the following criteria, i.e. South African citizens who are in possession of SA barcoded ID, unemployed, Should be parents/guardians with children at the school and living close to the school.

We do not have the requested information and as a result are unable to provide same as indicated in the above responses.
