Response:

1. The Tshwane Metro Police (TMPD) is in the process of establishing a Video and Camera Unit in our Land Invasion/Crowd Management Unit.

Ten (10) TMPD Land invasion/Crowd Management unit members have been trained by the South African Police Service (SAPS) as Video\Camera Operators.

One Hundred (100) TMPD Land Invasion/Crowd Management unit members have been trained by SAPS at the SAPS colleges, as instructed by the previous Police Commissioner that all Metro's be trained by the SAPS in Crowd Management.

All Policies, Standing Operating Procedures Guidelines et al currently adhere to are those of the South African Polices Services.
