- 9. Cross references to sources used this should be in the text in order for it to be checked easily
- 10. Individual description of identified cultural resources
- 11. Location of each identified cultural resource this should be indicated on a good map
- 12. Legislation
- 13. Evaluation of cultural resources (type, relative dating and condition to be included)
- 14. Evaluation of the impact of the development on cultural resources
- 15. Conclusion
- 16. Recommendations including mitigation measures
- 17. List of sources
- 18. Name of consultant (preferably on title page as this makes citation easy)
- 19. Date
- 20. Public Participation process. (If applicable)
