MEMO OF A MEETING WITH PIET DE JAGER SC, PRETORIA 6.6.97

This meeting was arranged at the request of witness Louw, who failed, however to attend.

Adv. De Jager represented MI before the Harms Commission in 1990, when Lubowski's MI link was disclosed in camera. He knows, therefore, what we require. He has also assisted in obtaining a comprehensive submission from a DCC source. He will do the same for us in this matter.

He says that he is only prepared to deal with us (Andre, Frans, Kobus) and no-one else in the TRC.

He requires from us a list of questions we would like to be answered.

He will also speak to Magnus and ask him if he will submit a statement on his disclosure in Parliament re Lubowski. (He represented Magnus in the Trust Feed case in Natal).

He has his clients' confidence but it will ultimately depend on them whether, and how far, they will co-operate. From his own knowledge he is certain that Lubowski was on the MI payroll, and that we will get the true story. He is also of the view that the murder was not linked to MI, and that the answer lies with the CCB's own agenda.
