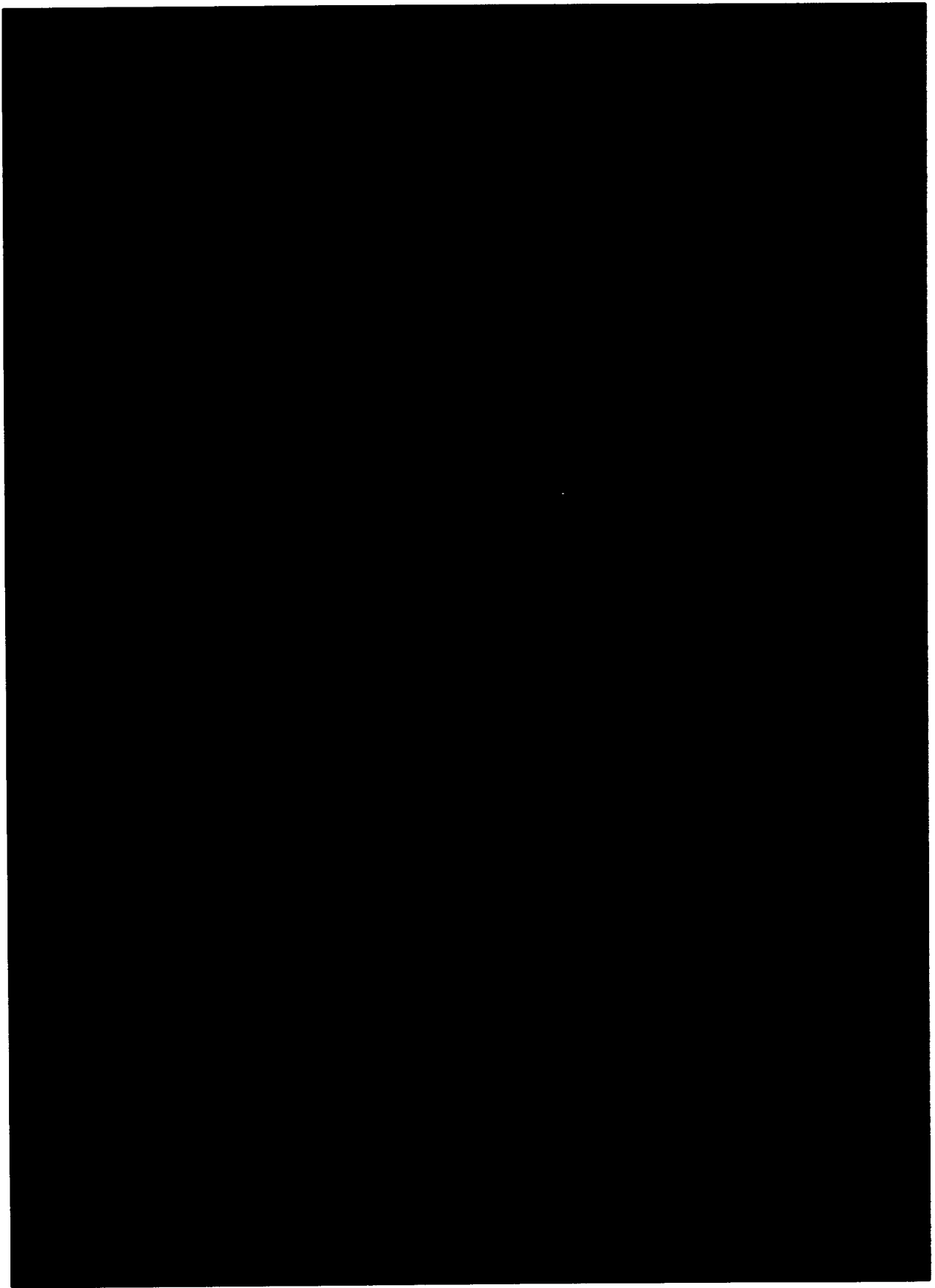
1. Request for access received on 2015-04-11 refers.
2. Any and all records reflecting an agreement between SAPS and the Mission Area Joint Operation Centre with respect to their position and role
 - A National Joint Operational and Intelligence Structure (NATJOINTS) instruction 02/2011 dated 2016-03-09 activating Joint Structure (Priority Committees) in all provinces to effectively address Rhino Poaching, through the implementation of integrated actions, (various departments: SAPS, SANDF, Intelligence, DEA, SANParks) and strategies to curb Rhino Poaching (**See Annexure A**).
 - The information related to the other role players should be requested from them.
3. Any and all records reflecting the number of employees attributed to the fight against Rhino Poaching, as well as their key responsibilities including but not limited to:
 - The total number of SAPS members deployed to the operation on a monthly basis were between 87 and 114 on a monthly basis.
 - These members were rotated (callup instruction) on a monthly basis to accommodate all functions needed during the operation and the threat assessment.

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- a. **Job profiles** (the following units were deployed in the operation)
- National Intervention Unit (NIU) – Medium risk operations, support to High risk operations.
 - Special Task Forces (STF) – High risk operations.
 - Tactical Response Teams (TRT) – Crime combating operations.
 - Visible Policing (K9 Unit) – Detection, access control, crime combating operations.
 - Detectives Services – Crime scene management and support to all cases reported.
 - Crime Intelligence – Gathering of related intelligence.
 - Forensic Services – Crime scene management and support to all cases reported.
 - Stock Theft Unit – Investigation of reported cases.
 - National Operational Coordination (NOC) – Coordination and monitoring of operation and forces deployed.
 - Legal Services – Provide legal support to operations and crime scene investigations, liaise with NPA in terms of prosecution.
 - Mobilisation Support Services – Provide mobile and logistical support to the operation and areas of deployment.
- b. See attached organogram (**Annexure B**) – Joint Integrated Structure (Joint Operational Coordinating Committee): JOCCOM with Tactical Joint Operational Centre's (TACJOC's) in the mission area.
