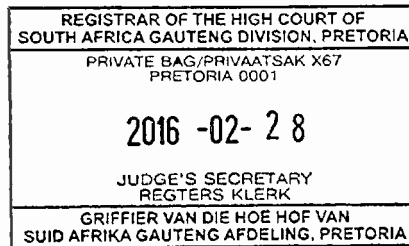

ORDER

HAVING HEARD COUNSEL for Applicant and having read the papers, the following order is granted:

1. The individual Respondents and employees of Second and Third Respondents and all other students and employees of Applicant's Potchefstroom campus (hereinafter referred to as "the University") are hereby ordered:

- 1.1 Not to interfere in any manner whatsoever with the rights of co-students, co-workers and administrative and academic staff of Applicant as far as lectures, sport events and ordinary campus activities are concerned and specifically not to picket in front of the University library or bar access to it.
- 1.2 Not to damage any property of Applicant or students or employees by arson or any other means.
- 1.3 To allow free and undisturbed access to the Potchefstroom campus to all members of the management of the University, students, staff and independent contractors and service providers to the University.
- 1.4 Not to intimidate students or employees of the University or of employees of Second and Third Respondents in any manner.
- 1.5 Not to interfere in any manner whatsoever with the managerial functions of the management of the University.
- 1.6 Not to incite violence or damage to property in any manner.
- 1.7 No to engage in illegal strikes, sit-ins or illegal gatherings or incite other individuals to do so.

2. This order must be made known in the following manner:
 - 2.1 By affixing a copy thereof in a prominent place at or nearby the main gate and all other access gates to the University and all notice boards of the University.
 - 2.2 By informing all registered students via sms of the existence of this order.
 - 2.3 By placing a copy thereof on the Facebook page of the University with the addition of the following message: *“A hard copy of the order will be available from Prof Marlene Verhoef at building C1 room 113.”*
 - 2.4 The management of Third Respondents are ordered to distribute the order and inform its content to all their employees employed at Applicant’s Potchefstroom campus.
 - 2.5 The management of the Second Respondent is ordered to distribute the following sms message to its employees of the Potchefstroom Campus: *“Court order granted to stop protest action, intimidation and violence. Go to office at 18A Du Plooy St on 29 February 2016 before reporting for duty to get full copy of order”.*
3. The South African Police Services (SAPS) are requested to assist Applicant insofar as it might be necessary for the proper and effective execution of this order; in particular the SAPS are authorised to enter the campus of the

University and to stay on campus for so long as it might in their view be necessary to assist Applicant.

4. The costs of this application are to be paid by Applicant save for the costs of any opposition thereto which will be sought against any opposing party.
