**NOTICE OF MOTION** 



TAKE NOTICE that at 14h30 on 11 March 2016, or so soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, the above-named Applicant intends making application to the above Honourable Court for relief in the following terms:

1 Directing that the usual forms and processes may be dispensed with, and this matter may be heard as one of urgency in terms of Rule 6(12);

- 2. An order directing the Respondents forthwith to vacate the Administration Building situate in Victoria Streets, Stellenbosch, and or the Student Centre of the Applicant, and or the Wilcocks building situate in Ryneveld Street, Stellenbosch, and or the Arts and Social Sciences Building, situate at the corner of Merriman Lane and Ryneveld Streets, Stellenbosch.
- 3. An order directing that a Rule *nisi* be issued calling upon the Respondents to appear and show cause, if any, to the above Honourable Court on 19 April 2016 at 10h00 or so soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, why an order should not be granted:
  - 3.1. Interdicting and restraining the Respondents from entering or occupying any building of the Applicant without lawful right to do so, including but not limited to:
  - 3.1.1. The Arts and Social Sciences building situate at the corner

of Merriman Lane and Ryneveld Street;

- 3.1.2. The Wilcocks building situate in Ryneveld Street;
- 3.1.3. The Administration buildings situate in Victoria and Ryneveld Streets;
- 3.1.4. The Student Centre of the Applicant.



- 3.2. Disrupting or otherwise interfering unlawfully in any way with the activities of the Applicant, including but not limited to:
- 3.2.1. the administration of the Applicant;
  - 3.2.2. all lectures, tutorials, official meetings and official events, including sporting and cultural events, on all campuses;
- 3.2.3. the work of all libraries;
- 3.2.4. graduation ceremonies;
- 3.2.5. examinations and tests; and
- 3.2.6. the Woordfees-festival.
- 3.3. Barricading any entrances to campuses or buildings of the Applicant;
- 3.4. Barricading any streets leading to campuses or buildings of the Applicant;
- 3.5. Damaging any buildings or other property of the Applicant;
  - 3.6. Damaging any other property, including motor vehicles, present on any of the Applicant's campuses;
  - 3.7. Intimidating, threatening, harassing, harming or detaining, or attempting to detain:
  - 3.7.1. any employees of the Applicant;
  - 3.7.2. any students of the Applicant; and



- 3.7.3. any persons present on any of the Applicant's campuses;
- 3.8. Inciting persons to re-occupy or to enter or occupy any building of the Applicant without lawful right to do so, including but not limited to the buildings described in paragraphs 3.1.1 and 3.1.4 above
- 3.9. Inciting persons to commit any of the acts described in paragraphs 3.2 to 3.8 above;
- 3.10. Directing the Respondents and any other persons opposing the confirmation of the rule nisi to pay the costs of this application, including the costs of two counsel;
- 3.11. Granting the Applicant such further and/or alternative relief as this Court may deem fit;
- 4. Directing that, pending the return day of the rule nisi, paragraphs 3.1 to 3.9 above shall operate as an interim interdict;
- 5. Directing that the Respondents may anticipate the return day of the rule nisi on 72 hours' written notice to the Applicant;
- 6. Directing the South African Police Services to assist the Applicant in enforcing this Order;
- 7. Directing that service of this Order shall be effected as follows:
  - 7.1. By posting a copy on the First Respondent's Facebook page at <a href="https://wwfacebook.comiopenstellenbosch">https://wwfacebook.comiopenstellenbosch</a>?fref=ts;
- 7.2. By posting it on the Applicant's website; and



7.3. By service by the Sheriff on the Respondents by reading it aloud by loudhailer outside the entrance to the buildings referred to in 3.1.1 to 3.1.4 above.

7.4. By sending a copy thereof to the email addresses of the Second - to Tenth Respondents.

8. Granting the Applicant such further and/or alternative relief as this Court may deem fit.
