
BY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS

- 1.3 Disrupt lectures, tests or examinations;
- 1.4 Enter into or attempt to enter university buildings for the purposes of either of the above activities, and preventing students or university staff from carrying out their lawful activities;
- 1.5 Damaging University property, or calling upon anyone else to do so; and
- 1.6 Obstruct and/or disrupt vehicular traffic entering the campus or on the campus.
- The Applicant hereby undertakes not to institute disciplinary action against the First to Twelfth Respondents as a result of the protest action that took place between 6 and 11 March 2014.





- The First to Twelfth Respondents undertake to cooperate with an 3. independent investigator appointed by the university's senior management to investigate the underlying causes of the protest action.
- 4. The Order is made final in respect of the Thirteenth Respondent.
