ORDER

Having heard the oral evidence and counsel on behalf of the Applicant, the following order is granted:

- 1. a *rule nisi* calling on the first to thirteenth Respondents to show cause on 22 March 2016 why the following order should not be made final:
 - 1.1. Interdicting and restraining first to thirteenth of the respondents from any action that obstructs or frustrates the effective rendering of university services or decision-making processes of the applicant, including, but not limited to:
 - 1.1.1. entering or occupying any of the applicant's premises other than for providing services that requires their attendance at UWC premises.
 - 1.1.2. destroying or defacing any of the applicant's property;
 - 1.1.3. participating in, or inciting others to participate in, unlawful or violent protest;



1.1.4. inciting violence.

- 1.2. Costs against any of the respondents that oppose the application.
- 1.3. Further and/or alternative relief.
- 2. The *rule nisi* in paragraphs 1.1 and 1.2 above shall operative as an interim interdict with immediate effect until the final resolution of the matter.
- 3. the applicant file its founding papers on or before Thursday 10 March 2016;
 - 3.1. that in the event of any of the respondents opposing the relief sought in Part B of this application, that they:
 - i. deliver to the applicant a notice of opposition and to appoint in such notice an address, within 15km of the office of the Registrar of this court, at which they will accept notice and service of all process in these proceedings by not later than 10h00 on <u>Friday 4</u> March 2016.
 - ii. deliver any affidavits they may desire to make in answer to the allegations made by and on behalf of the applicant by no later than 16h00 on Wednesday 16 March 2016.



- 4. A copy of this order has to be served on the Respondents as soon as possible
 - 4.1. By placing on the notice boards at the Applicant's premises.
 - 4.2. On site offices of thirteenth, fourteenth and fithteenth Respondents.
- 5. South African Police Services and Metro Police are authorised and directed to assist the Applicant in effecting the implementation of this order.
- 6. Any of the Respondents may anticipate the return of this interim order on not less than twenty-four hours written notice to the Applicant's attorney of record Mr. Lionel Egypt from Cliffe Dekker Hofmeyr Inc. (Tel: 021 481 6426/ 082 3742547)
- 7. The parties are directed to explain in any further paper filed of record in this matter whether or not thete are prepared to submit the conflict that currently exists between them to mediation.
- 8. In the event that they are not prepared to do so to provide the court with an explanation for such refusal.
- 9. That evidence is to be transcribed as soon as possible and to be served in accordance with clause 4 herein.
