

CODE OF CONDUCT OF THE ANTI-PRIVATISATION FORUM

(As adopted by the APF CC in June 2007)

1. Observance of Policies

- a) It is expected that each APF member must observe the policies of the organisation
- b) Each member shall make it his/her responsibility to ensure that the APF policies are respected and observed by other activists and members.
- c) Each member shall regard his/her responsibility to report for discussion any transgression of such policies in order for the organisation to take the necessary corrective and disciplinary measures
- d) Each member accepts that a material transgression of policy shall result in disciplinary action being taken

2. Discipline

- a) Members are to respect each other irrespective of gender
- b) Personal relationships between members cannot be regulated. However, members are encouraged not to let such relationships interfere with the work of the organisation and participation therein.
- c) Members are to respect each others views and organisations.
- d) Members are expected to be responsible and accountable when using the resources of the organisation.

3. Meetings

- a) Members are expected to keep time when they come to meetings
- b) Members are expected to submit apologies when either not coming to meetings or leaving early
- c) Members are expected to submit apologies when they are going to be late for meetings/activities
- d) Members are expected to stay for the duration of the meeting once they have received their transport monies unless an apology has been submitted
- e) Members are expected to raise their hands when wanting to speak in the meeting
- f) Mobile phones are to switched off during the meetings

4. Participation

- a) Members are expected to fully participate, where required, in all meetings and events organised by the organisation
- b) Members are expected to fully participate when delegated by their affiliate in the subcommittees of the organisation

- c) Members are expected to read and distribute, where appropriate, the media produced by the organisation

5. Accountability

- a) Members are expected to generally be accountable for their actions and views
 - b) Members are expected to account, as per the relevant policy, for any monies obtained from the organisation
 - c) Members are expected to carry out the tasks allocated and delegated to them
 - d) Members are expected to act, when representing the APF or their affiliates, on the basis of a mandate
 - e) Members are generally expected to carry out and respect the decisions of the organisation.
